

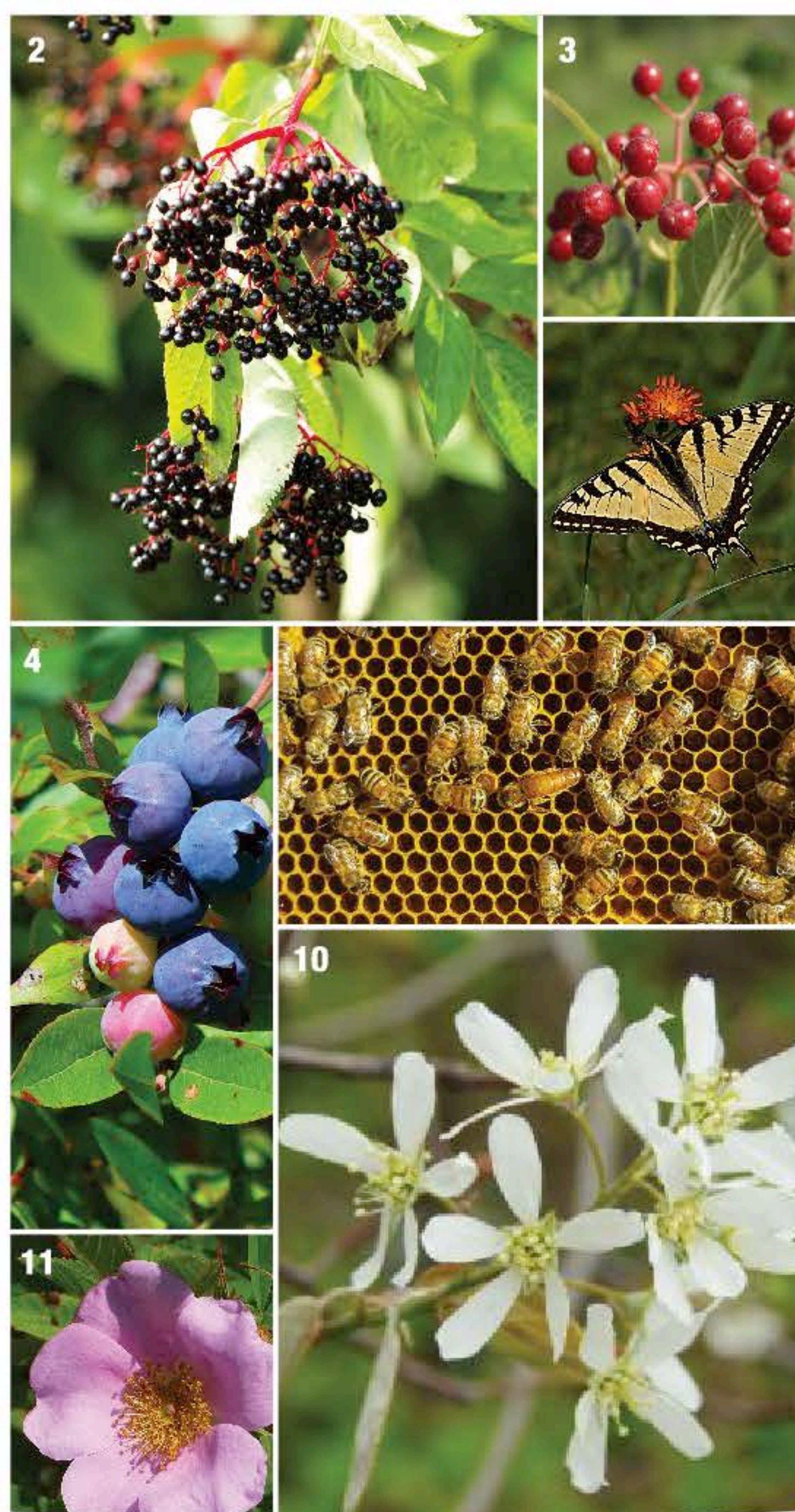
Best for the Biosphere

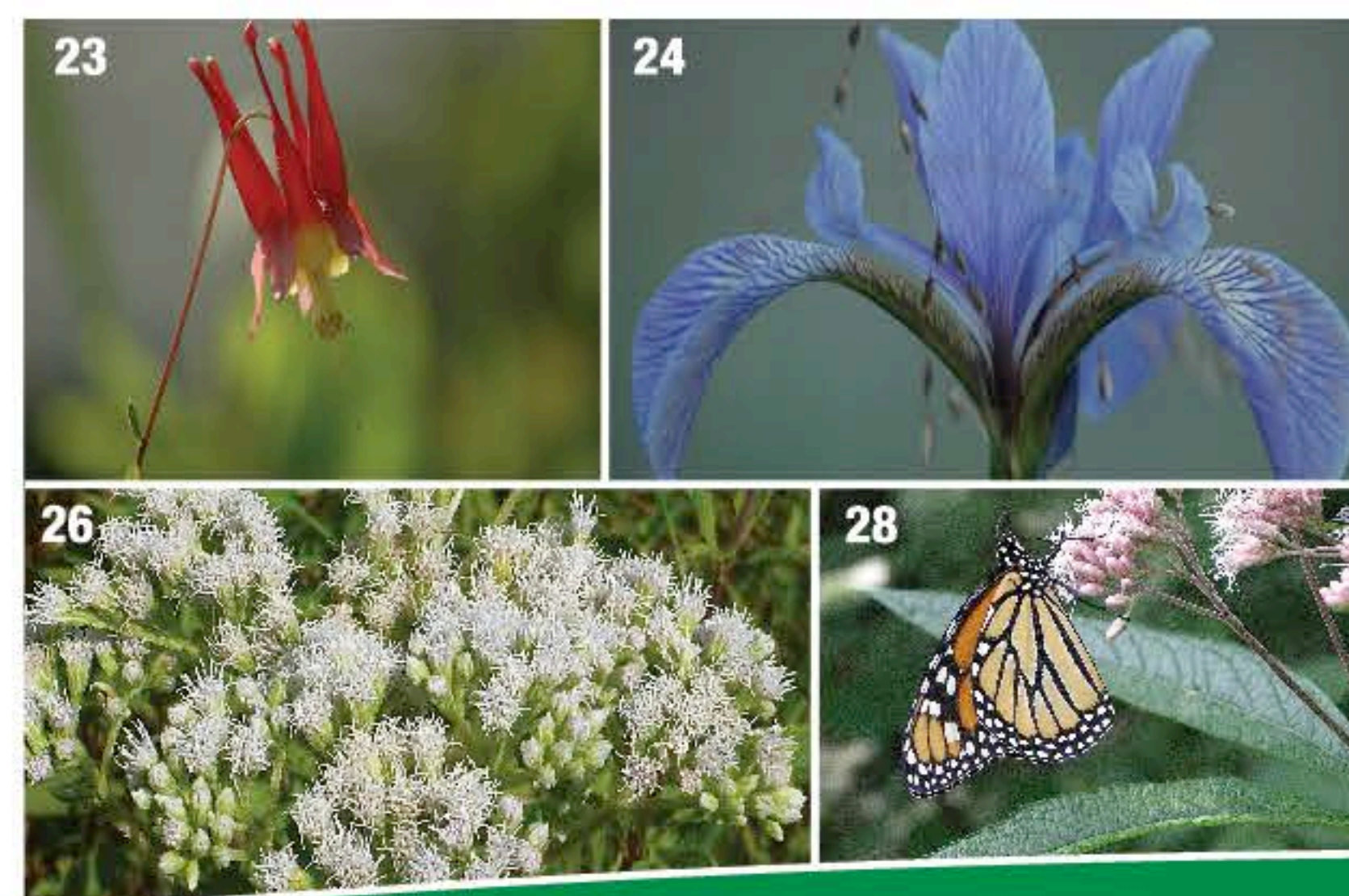
